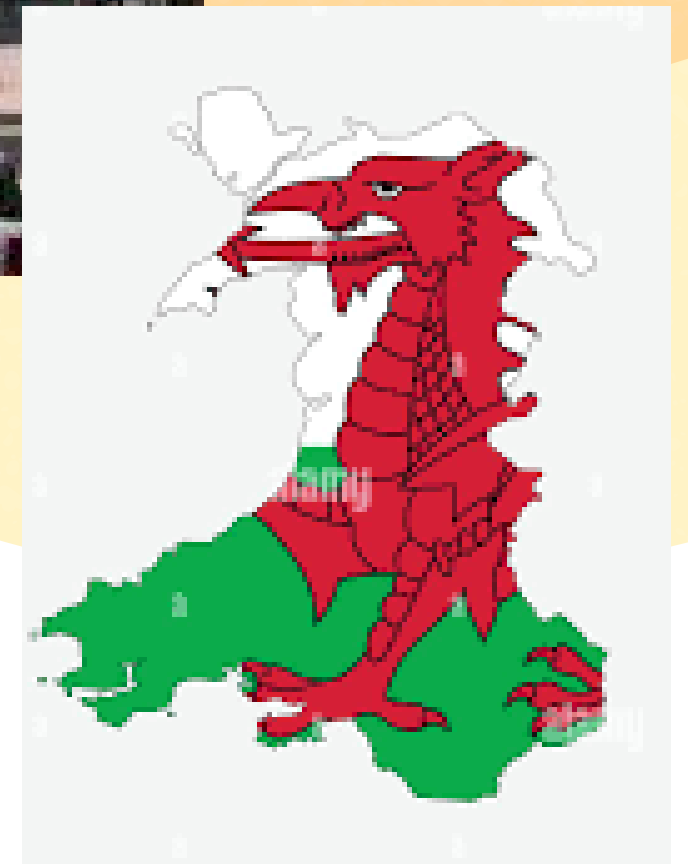
Areas of Learning and Experience

Our curriculum provides learning experiences through the six AOLE's



LEARNING

- Our curriculum will embrace the wealth of experiences which exist with our local area, **Ystradgynlais**.
- This will allow our pupils to develop a sense of **Cynefin**.
- It will draw upon the **pedagogical principles**.
- Pupils will be given the opportunity to decide upon what they want to learn through **‘Dysgu Gyda’n Gilydd’**



ASSESSMENT & PROGRESSION

- Effective teaching and learning across the curriculum enables learners to make meaningful progress.
- Over time our learners will develop, improve and deepen their skills, knowledge and understanding.
- This supports our approach to assessment which informs planning and steps forward for future learning.
- All learners are assessed on entry into school and their progress is reviewed and monitored regularly.



CROSS CUTTING THEMES

Our curriculum incorporates five cross cutting themes

- **Relationships and Sexual Education**

Our RSE curriculum helps children to form and maintain relationships based on mutual trust and respect. It explores sexuality and healthy relationships in an age appropriate manner.

- **Human Rights**

Through our curriculum we provide opportunities for children to develop their knowledge about Human rights, citizenship and ethical action. They develop an understanding of UNCRC and UNCRPD.

- **Diversity**

Our curriculum reflects the diverse nature of social groups and communities. Children become increasingly aware of specific characteristics which can define our identity.

- **Careers and Work related Experiences**

Our curriculum enables children to gain experiences related to work and careers, developing knowledge of the breadth of opportunities to them throughout their lives.



- **Local, National & International Contexts**
